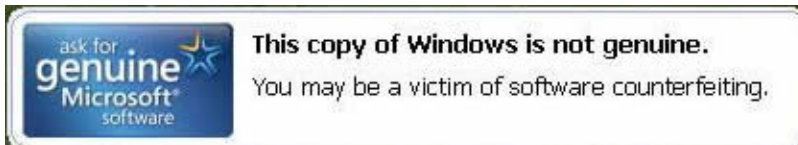


GENUINE MICROSOFT SOFTWARE

Each year, millions of consumers worldwide are victimized by software piracy. In July of 2005, Microsoft launched Windows Genuine Advantage to help consumers quickly and easily identify whether their copy of Windows is genuine or not. Since then, WGA has assisted thousands of customers who have discovered that their copy of Windows is not genuine. Many of these customers were taken advantage by unscrupulous resellers, and others mistakenly purchased high quality counterfeit software. Regardless of the situation Microsoft will try to provide assistance and support in resolving the problem.

Make sure you are purchasing from a vendor that declare 100% authenticate software. Many times the counterfeit software looks just like the real thing. What we have seen is that either the hologram CD is really a "colored" CD, not a true hologram. We have also seen vendors that have sold volume license keys. Volume license keys must be registered to a single corporation and there is stipulations around these licenses. We have found vendors that would purchase volume license keys and then resell the key over and over again.
