Is your accounting data really backed up?

Depending on how your backups are setup and where your data file is located, your accounting information may not be getting backed up because it is not a backed up directory. Also consider that if your accounting packages have a manual backup, you may want to back up to a USB Flash drive before you go home every night. *If you run an automatic server backup,*

*but your company's file is open (running) on **anyone's** computer when it's time for the backup to take place, **your file will not be backed up!*** Why? Because if the file is open, it's considered a "live" database file, so backup programs will skip over it – not what you want!
